AKC CGC Certification requirements

Week 1:

- #1 - Shows proof dog is in care of vet (shot records) #3 - Owner describes exercise plan (discuss importance)
- #9 - Fit Collars for Training (owner choice) #10 - Owner can hug or hold puppy #14 - Walks on leash, follows owner in straight line #15 - Walks by other people

Week 2:

- #7 - Free of aggression toward people
- #8 - Free of aggression toward other dogs
- #11 - Dog allows owner to take away treat or toy #16 - Sits on command (owner can use food)

Week 3:

- #12 - Allows petting by someone other than owner (a)
- #20 - Stay on leash with another person (b)
- #17 - Down on command (owner can use food)

Week 4:

- #18 - Comes to owner from 10 ft
- #19 - Reaction to distractions

Week 5:

- #6 - Owner has obtained some form of ID (e.g. tag) #13 - Grooming (touching, doing actual grooming) #20- Stay at 20 ft

Week 6:

- #2 - Dog appears healthy & active for breed
- #4 - Attends all 6 classes (c)
- #5 - Owner brings bags for clean up to class #7 - Free from aggression toward people #8 - Free from aggression toward other dogs
